Entering and Exiting the School

Due to child protection reasons <u>NO parents are allowed inside of the school building</u>. The class drop off points are outlined below. If you need to contact your teacher, they will be opening the doors at 8.50am every morning. You can also contact via Seesaw or leave a message by telephoning the office.

Nursery- Side gate of nursery outdoor play area. (Enter and Exit)

P1- P1 fire doors at the back of the school. (Enter and Exit)

<u>P2-</u> Line up outside the classroom windows. They will enter through the P2/P3 fire doors. Exit through via the Community Room door which is located at the front of the building beside the bike shelter.

<u>P3-</u> Line up outside the classroom windows. (Enter and Exit)

<u>P4-</u> P4 fire doors at the front playground (Enter and Exit)

P5- P4 fire doors at the front playground (Enter and Exit)

<u>P5/6</u>- Community Room doors (Enter and Exit)

<u>P6/7-</u> Foyer front doors of the school (Enter and Exit)

Please be aware that breakfast club does not run on the last day of term (half day party days)
